The Eternal Foundation of God's Character and Government

THE MOST EFFECTIVE AND POWERFUL teaching system ever created was the sanctuary God gave to the ancient Hebrew people. It was both practical and prophetic, because it both explained the steps that a person must take in order to experience the salvation God offers and it also foretold the coming of the Savior and the steps He would need to take to accomplish human salvation. The inner sanctum of the sanctuary was called the Most Holy Place. It contained one article of furniture, called the "ark of the covenant," which was a golden chest containing the Ten Commandment Law of God and covered with a gold lid called "the mercy seat." Above it was the radiant light of God's presence, called the Shekinah glory. It is highly significance that the book of Revelation states that in the in the end-time period of human history the temple of God will be "seen" (realized, understood) by His people and they will become keepers of His Commandments. The Law of God figures prominently into the end-time.

The Symbolism of The Sanctuary

Exodus 25:8-9—⁸ And let them make Me a _____, that I may dwell among them. ⁹ According to all that I show you, that is, the pattern of the tabernacle and the _____ of all its furnishings, just so you shall make it.

Exodus 34:28— He wrote on the tablets the words of the _____, the Ten Commandments.

Hebrews 8:1-2—¹ We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, ² a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.

Psalms 77:13—Your way, O God, is in the sanctuary.

John 14:6—I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

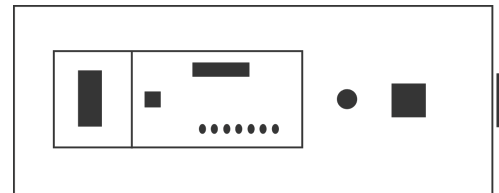
The Temple Opened in The End-time

Revelation 12:17—The dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 14:12—¹² Here is the patience of the saints; here *are* those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus.

The Lawless One: MO of The Antichrist

Daniel 7:25—He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, shall persecute the saints of the Most High, and shall intend to change times and law.

1 Thessalonians 2:3-10—³ Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, ⁴ who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God... ⁷ For the mystery of **lawlessness** is already at work... ⁸ And then **the lawless one** will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. ⁹ The coming of **the lawless one** is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, ¹⁰ and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Jesus Exalts The Law

Isaiah 42:21—The LORD is well pleased for His righteousness' sake; He will _____ the law and make it honorable.

Daniel 9:26-27—²⁶ Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself...²⁷ Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering.

Daniel 11:22—...the Prince of the _____.

Hebrews 10:16-17—¹⁶ This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the LORD: I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them, ¹⁷ then He adds, their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.

God's Law of Love Will Be Established By Faith

Romans 6:1-4, 14-17—¹ What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? ² Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? ³ Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? ⁴ Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life... ¹⁴ For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace. ¹⁵ What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? Certainly not!

Romans 3:31—Do we then make void the law through faith? Certainly _____!
On the contrary, we establish the law.

John 14:15—If you _____ Me, keep My commandments.

1 John 2:3—³ Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. ⁴ He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

Matthew 22:36-40—³⁷ You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' ³⁸ This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹ And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."
